

- STEP 3: IF/ONCE APPROVED THE NEXT STEP WOULD BE A MINOR SUBDIVISION PLAT TO COMBINE TWO PARCELS INTO ONE WHICH COULD TAKE ADDITIONAL 1-2 MONTHS
